Tying a Half Windsor knot in your tie is easy. Half Windsor knot is said to have been invented by the Duke of Windsor. It's a great look that you should try when tying your necktie.

Here are some sample instructions on how you can tie a tie using the classic Half Windsor knot.

**Step 1:** Place your tie so that the left side end "A" is longer than the side B and cross side A over the side B.



**Step 2:** Next bring side B up around and behind side A.



**Step 3:** Now, bring side B up.



**Step 4:** Next, pull side B up and through the loop in front.



**Step 5:** Now bring side A around front, over side B from left to right.



**Step 6:** Again, bring side A up and through the loop.

Continued:

**Step 7:** Bring the side A down through the newly created knot in front.



**Step 8:** Using both hands, gently tighten the Half Windsor knot and draw it up snugly the collar.



The Half Windsor knot truly looks best when you wear it with a spread collar shirt; which incidentally is how the Duke of Windsor originally wore it. Tie this tie right and you'll look like Royalty! Still confused?
